

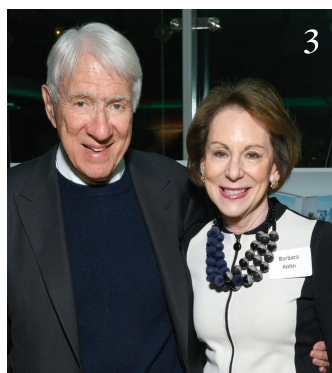
ON THE SCENE

STREET OF DREAMS

THE PARTY Dranoff Properties hosted Pulitzer Prize-winning architecture critic Paul Goldberger for a panel discussion about the development and future of Philadelphia's famous Avenue of the Arts. The revitalization of this stretch of South Broad Street began in 1993 under Governor Ed Rendell.
